To this end, and as a supplement to the Quality of our products, if necessary LEVENTON S.A.U. provides training on its products through different channels, including nurses who provide in-service training to the end customer.
- ensuring that the internal manufacturing processes are robust and focused on avoiding risks to the safety and health of LEVENTON S.A.U. employees. These processes are supervised by internal and external Committees.
- guaranteeing the ongoing training, competence and motivation of employees of LEVENTON S.A.U., through Training Programs and the creation of a positive atmosphere of communication, which is evaluated by management on a regular basis.
- the awareness and training of employees in the Culture of Quality, through the effective and dynamic implementation of the Quality System with risk analysis as a key element for the decision- making of for prevention, planning and continuous improvement that allow LEVENTON S.A.U. to achieve ever greater levels of demand.
- strict compliance with all applicable regulations (products, processes, equipment and facilities) as well as preparing in advance our suitability for updates that may appear
- compliance with the Code of Ethics established by the Werfen Group.
